- Acknowledge and welcome Alix (Karen Thomas)
 - Karen welcomed everyone and thanked the Simmons staff members for helping out with planning of the Simmons AAFW weekend
 - o Karen welcomed, Alix Laager, a Simmons trustee and parent as the keynote speaker

• Alix Laager, Simmons Trustee

- Alix spoke about how her daughter chose to came to Simmons and felt like she found a community at Simmons
- Alix spoke about the foundation of Simmons and how it was created to help women get an education so they can support themselves
- She spoke about how Simmons adapts to the current market needs and goals behind it.
 She touched upon the academic re-design to align with what students are currently thinking about and what they are interested in.
- Alix touched upon the 125th anniversary goals for Simmons as the chair of Board of Trustees Advancement committee. Their goal is to have 25% alums participate as part of the fundraising campaign for the 125th anniversary.

• Director of Student Outreach, Courtney Bryant

- o Courtney was joined by Sunei Clarke, the president of SGA at Simmons
- Courtney spoke about her role of coordinating with seniors and the student body. She
 joined the student body earlier in the fall where she welcomed the incoming freshman at a
 candle lighting ceremony. Each freshman was gifted a key chain from the Simmons
 Alumni Association.
- Sunei spoke about some of the student body initiatives going around the campus
 - Having accessible programming around campus to ensure that students with disabilities also feel welcomed as well as included.
 - Access to free feminine hygiene products on Simmons residence campus is another goal where they hope to stock 60% of the residence campus communal bathrooms by the end of the year
 - The student body is amidst special elections to select a board for the senior class council as none of the executive board positions are currently filled.
 - Sunei spoke about working on a theme of "creating good trouble" for the SGA and student body. The goal with this theme is to learn about occupying spaces, taking over and making your presence visible

• Treasurer, Barbara Campbell

- Barbara spoke about the major income of the Simmons Alumni Association is from the commission received when any Simmons student or alum purchases a Simmons insurance policy with Liberty Mutual. Another source of income are the funds received via investments in the Vanguard fund
- Majority of expenses for the Alumni Association are attributed towards programming for Simmons students on campus, sponsoring alumni awards and alumni grants
